#### NOTE

N placing this extract from my large illustrated Catalogue of "Old Masters" before the public, I have been prompted by the desire to rescue these reproductions from oblivion, into which they otherwise might have fallen. Pictures in public collections, accessible to everyone, are not likely to be forgotten; pictures gathered for a special purpose for once and for once only are as good as buried so soon as the privacy of their owner's residence has embraced them, and it is only in reproductions, such as mine I hope will be found, that the world at large can enjoy to some extent these hidden treasures.

The reproductions mentioned in this list are taken from pictures at one time or the other collected at the Royal Academy, the New Gallery and the Guildhall, viz., the Rembrandt Exhibition of 1899 (Royal Academy), the Van Dyck Exhibition of 1900 (*ibid.*), the Exhibition of Flemish and British Schools of 1899-1900 (New Gallery), the "Spanish Painters" Exhibition, 1901 (Guildhall).

The reproductions themselves were executed with the greatest

care, and I take this opportunity of expressing my sincere thanks to the owners of the originals and the directors of the different institutions



for the facilities given to me. No labour was spared to make these monochrome translations as faithful as the photographic lens and the photographer's skill will permit, so that they should form a source of pleasure even to those



to whom the originals may not be known.

Who would not, for instance, be glad to call to his mind once more

such works as Mr. Fitzwilliam's



or Sir Alg. Neeld's Rembrandt (R. Ex. 43 and 4)? Who would not care to refresh his memory of pictures such as the Duke of Buccleuch's "Marquess of Huntley," by Van Dyck (V. D. Ex. 10), v. D. 40.



or the Duke of Norfolk's "Earl of Arundel" (ibid. 40), by the same artist? A most remarkable collection of pictures was brought together



in the New Gallery's Winter Exhibition of 1899-1900, interesting not only to experts, who were particularly delighted with some of M. de Somzee's priceless panels (Fl. Ex. 26, etc.), but also to the less complex appreciation of the FL



lay art lover (see for instance Romney's "Mrs. de Bergh," belonging to Mr. Donaldson (Fl. Ex. 203), or Hoppner's "Child with a Dog" (Fl. Ex. 202), Mr. Butler's property. The Spanish Exhibition is perhaps too recent to have been forgotten. There Goya, of whose merits as a painter



little or nothing was generally known in this country, was found almost equal in interest (see his "Portrait of Melendez-Valdes," Sp. Ex. 66, belonging to the Bowes Museum, or his "Portrait of La Señora de Céan Bermudez,"



lent by the Marqués de Casa-Torres, Sp. Ex. 63), if not in technique, with his giant predecessor Velazquez, who is represented in my collection,



amongst others, by such instructive works as Sir Frederick Cook's "Spanish Beggar" (Sp. Ex. 104), the Duke of Westminster's "Don Baltasar in the Riding School" (Sp. Ex. 127), and Mr. Leatham's "Young Man" (Sp. Ex. 123).



If this little list, which I have-for reference purposes-carefully and fully illustrated, is received in the spirit in which it is offered, it



will be the means of supplying art lovers and experts with a source of pleasure and instruction, and of proving to me that I have not spent valuable time and labour in vain.

F—denotes Folio Size= $10 \times 8$  inches. Price, Permanent Carbon Photo 3s. Silver Print 1s. 6d.

R—denotes Royal Size= $15 \times 12$  inches. Price, in either finish . . . 6s.

I—denotes Imperial Size= $21 \times 16$  inches. Price, in either finish . . . 12s.

E—denotes Extra Size= $34 \times 26$  inches. Price, in either finish . . . 5os.

The letters and figures under each illustration signify the Exhibition the picture was in and the number under which it was catalogued. Thus: F. 26 means Flemish and British Exhibition, No. 26, and further details will be found in the corresponding section of this list, which is arranged in the numerical order of the Official Catalogues. D. stands for Van Dyck Exhibition; R. for Rembrandt, and Sp. for the Spanish Exhibition.

NOTE.—When ordering it is only necessary to quote size and Order Number with all Initials. A Royal of Van Dyck's "Lord Wharton" should be ordered thus: 1 R. St. P. 92, etc.
